ANNUAL ARTS COMPETITION 2023 - Rules & Regulations

Sl. No	GENERAL RULES				
1.	Completed application forms has to be submitted ONLINE on or before 05 th October 2023 along with details of entry fee paid.				
2.	Participants are requested to login into www.aac.ttfac.org.in and update their personal information. Group is decided on the class/standard in which the participant is studying for group A, B and C. Ensure class/standard is updated in their respective login. If there is any difficulty in logging, please mail to ttfac@hotmail.com				
3.	Group A :- Up to Standard IV Group B :- Standard V, VI and VII Group C :- Standard VIII, IX and X Group D :- All the rest. Group E :- Participants born and brought up in Kerala (This group is there for Only Malayalam Reading.)				
4.	For group events, all the participants shall belong to the same group. Maximum of 7 members allowed for group items.				
5.	Minimum 3 entries are required in a group (A, B, C, D and E) for conducting the events; otherwise the competition on that event shall be cancelled for that group and entry fee will be refunded				
6.	Participants are not allowed to use fire, crackers, sharp objects like knife, sword etc on the stage. Use of such materials will lead to disqualification.				
7.	Participants who sprinkle any material like colour powder, flowers etc shall clean the stage after their performance. The time spent in cleaning shall be considered to be part of their performance.				
8.	Participants are to be present at the venue while issuing chest number. Entry will be cancelled and no refund of entry fees for absentees				
9.	Entry fee will not be refunded.				
10.	TTFAC has the right to make any change in the rules and regulations if necessary. Same will be intimated in advance.				
11.	No accompanying music allowed for vocal items. However, shruti box is allowed for Classical Music				
12.	Decision of the judges is final.

1.	Singing & Mapilappattu ➡ Time limit is 6 minutes.				
2.	Group song ➡ Time limit is 6 minutes. Film songs may attract negative grading.				
3.	Nadan Pattu (Group-Malayalam) ➡ Time limit is 6 minutes. Traditional instruments can be used and it has to be used only by the participants. Electronic instruments and karaoke are not allowed.

4.	Recitation (Malayalam) ➡ Time limit is 8 minutes.
5.	Classical Music ➡ Shruti Box must be used. Time limit is 8 minutes.
6.	Cinematic Dance (Solo-Malayalam) & Group Dance (Malayalam) ➡ Song has to be submitted in pen drive (MP3 or WAV format) at least 30 minutes before the event. Multiple songs should not be combined together).
7.	Folk Dance (Solo-Malayalam) ➡ Song has to be submitted in pen drive (MP3 or WAV format) at least 30 minutes before the event. Film songs may attract negative marks.
8.	Classical Dance (Bharatanatyam & Mohiniyattam) ➡ Traditional dance form has to be performed. Make up and costumes will be considered for evaluation. Song should be submitted in pen drive (MP3 or WAV format) at least 30 minutes before the event. Time limit is 10 minutes.
9.	Fancy Dress ➡ Playback sound is allowed.
10.	Mimicry & Mono Act ➡ Presentation has to be in Malayalam. Time limit is 5 minutes
11.	Tableau (It can be Solo or Group) ➡ Playback sound can be used and it has to be given at least 30 minutes before the event in pen drive (MP3 or WAV format).
12.	One Act Play (Malayalam) ➡ Script has to be submitted for approval at least 5 days before the competition. Time limit is 30 minutes (Including stage setup).
13.	Mime (Solo) ➡ Playback sound can be used and it has to be given at least 30 minutes before the event in pen drive (MP3 or WAV format). Time limit is 10 minutes.
14.	Extempore speech (Malayalam & English) ➡ Subject will be given 5 minutes before. Participants are not allowed inside the auditorium before his/her chest number being called. Time limit is 5 minutes.
15.	Elocution (Malayalam & English) ➡ Subject will be given 3 days in advance via WhatsApp. Time limit is 5 minutes.
16.	Instrumental Music ➡ No accompanying music allowed. Power point and audio cable will be provided on stage if required. Shruthi Box may be used. Time limit is 5 minutes.
17.	Pencil Drawing ➡ Only drawing sheet will be provided (A3 size). Subject/Theme will be announced prior to the event. Time limit is 2 hours.
18.	Painting ➡ Only drawing sheet will be provided (A3 size). Subject/Theme will be announced prior to the event. Time limit is 2 hours. Group A & B participants can use any colouring method including crayons. Group C & D should use only water colour or oil paint.
19.	Essay Writing, Story Writing & Poetry Writing ➡ a) Group A, B, C ➡ Only paper will be provided (A4 size ruled). Subject will be announced prior to the event. Time limit is one hour. b) Group D ➡ Subject will be announced in advance. Hand written or printed articles has to be submitted to the club office on or before 09 th October 2023 (Time: between 08.00 PM to 09.00 PM). Criteria: - Poetry - Maximum 40 lines, Story - Maximum 5 pages (300 lines), Essay - Maximum 10 pages (600 lines). Only fresh articles are allowed. Once published in any online platform or magazines or entered in any competitions are not allowed.
20.	Malayalam Calligraphy ➡ Only paper will be provided (A4 size ruled). Matter will be given prior to the event. Time limit is 30 minutes.
21.	Malayalam Reading ➡ Reading materials will be given 5 minutes in advance.

23.	Photography Competition ➡ a) The competition is open to everyone and there is no age bar. b) There will be four (04) themes/subjects 1. Nature 2. Festival 3. Life around us 4. Face / Portraits c) Each theme shall have two categories. 1. Mobile (photographs shot only using mobile) 2. Other than mobile. d) Maximum of three (03) photographs can be submitted in each category. That means one participant can submit maximum 24 images. e) Each photograph will be considered as a separate entry and entry fee shall be paid for each photograph. f) Photographs shall be uploaded in TTFAC website. Link for uploading photographs will be circulated through social media and e-mail. g) By virtue of submitting an image, the entrant certifies the work as his/her own. h) An image submitted in one category shall not be submitted for other categories. i) No alterations of images are allowed for Nature, Festival & Life around us. j) No images are allowed with watermarks/identification. k) TTFAC shall have all the rights to use these photographs for any purpose as decided by the managing committee, with due credit to the photographer. l) Size each image to a maximum of 1920 pixels wide and 1080 pixels high. Photos must be in JPEG format. Colour space should be sRGB. Image file size should not exceed 2MB.
